The Director of Social Welfare, AP, Hyderabad, vide reference 1st and 3rd read above, has stated that out of (332) College Hostels sanctioned in Andhra Pradesh, (256) are functioning with a strength of 16,196. The existing procedure for sanction of mess charges prescribed in G.O.Ms.No.89, SW(Q2) Dept., dt:09-08-1996 that the inmates of College Hostels shall be sanctioned by meeting the expenditure from out of the Budget "Post Matric Scholarships". The in-charge HWOs of these Colleges Hostels are incurring expenditure in advance till the MTF budget is released to them under the Post Matric Scheme. This is having its own adverse impact on the quality of menu being implemented in these hostels and there is dissatisfaction due to this among the boarders of the College Hostels as well as the HWOs who are running these hostels. Hence, the District Officers are requesting for release of mess charges (MTF) for College Hostels under head of account under Diet Charges to enable them to provide uninterrupted supply of Diet to the College Hostel Boarders.

2. Further, the Director of Social Welfare, AP, Hyderabad has stated that in the G.O.Ms.No.147, Finance (BG.I) Dept., Dt:11-07-2011, Govt. have issued instruction with regard to flow of funds for smooth functioning of flagship programmes/schemes under "Green Channel" w.e.f. 2011-12. The Green Channel schemes include, among others, all essential items relating to smooth functioning of hostels run by all Welfare Departments. The Backward Class Welfare Department is providing diet to the Boarders of the Post Matric College Hostels in the Green Channel for the timely release of funds.

3. The Director of Social Welfare, AP, Hyderabad has requested the Government for orders permitting drawal of mess charges of College Hostels (Departmental Attached Hostels) from Post Matric Scholarships (MTF) to Diet Charges.

4. The Nodal Agency for Scheduled Castes Sub-Plan (SCSP) as well as the State Council for the Development of SCs & STs have approved to change the Budget Head for the release of the Mess Charges of the Social Welfare College Hostels (Departmental Attached Hostels) from Maintenance Fee under Scholarships to Diet Charges.

5. In the above circumstances reported by the Director of Social Welfare, AP, Hyderabad and in accordance with the approval of State Council for the Development of SCs & STs, the Government hereby orders for change of the Budget Head for the release of the Mess Charges of the Social Welfare College Hostels (Departmental Attached Hostels) from Maintenance Fee under Scholarships to Diet Charges as detailed below to provide uninterrupted supply of Diet to the Social Welfare College Hostels (Departmental Attached Hostels) Boarders.

6. The Monthly Diet Charges (Mess charges) as prescribed by the Govt. for the boarders admitted into the College Hostels for Boys and Girls under the administrative control of the S.C. Welfare Department shall be strictly followed without any deviations while incurring the expenditure every month for providing diet to the S.C. boarders.

7. The Director of Social Welfare is hereby requested to take necessary action for making budgetary changes; online software changes both in e-pass & e-hostel portals.
