In the G.O. 1st read above, Government have issued consolidated orders on the applicability of various tuition fee and special fee for the SC Students studying in various Para Medical Courses towards the Government quota seats and the Management seats in the Private Institutions, as detailed below, or the actual fee charged by the Institutions for the courses whichever is less:-

2. The fees for Management quota is three to five times higher than the fees prescribed for the Government quota seats. In view of the difference in fees structure, certain management have resorted to malpractice by showing the students under the Government quota as if they were selected under the Management quota in order to avail the higher fees.

3. Therefore in order to ensure that the Private Management of the

various Para Medical Institutions do not misuse the fee rates applicable to the SC Students under the Management Quota, it was decided to form Joint Inspection teams at both at the State and the District Level by conducting inspections periodically to ensure that the Private managements are following strictly the guidelines issued by the Government for filling up the seats as per the fees fixed by the Government under Government quota and management quota.

4. Accordingly orders were issued in the G.O. second read above for constituting State Level Committee with Commissioner of Social Welfare, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and the Director of Medical Education and the District Level Committee with Deputy Director (SW), Director of Medical and Health Officer and the Principal of the Medical Colleges for thorough and joint inspection. The District Level Committee are to function under the supervision of the District Collector and payment of scholarships shall be made only after joint inspections are conducted.

5. In the reference 3rd read above, the Commissioner of Social Welfare has stated that in G.O.Ms.No.66 Social Welfare (Edn.2) Department dt.08.09.2010 detailed guidelines were issued for streamlining the Post Matric Scholarships. Among them it was also clearly stipulated that students selected in management quota or spot admission quota are not eligible to get Post Matric Scholarships. Thus the management quota was removed from the scholarships scheme.

6. The Commissioner of Social Welfare has also stated that in view of the above, G.O.Ms.No.5 Social Welfare (Edn.2) Department dt.12-01-2005 is not relevant in the present context of online scholarships as the same was issued keeping in view of the sanction of PMS to management quota seats relating to paramedical courses at that time. The Commissioner of Social Welfare has therefore stated that it may not be necessary to implement G.O.Ms.No.5, Social Welfare (Edn.2) Department dt.12-01-2005.

7. Government after detailed examination of the matter, hereby with-draw the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.5, Social Welfare (Edn.2) Department dt.12-01-2005 with immediate effect.


